AWARD ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS & JUDGING CRITERIA

(Please see Registration Form for Application Requirements):

USGBC NCR Project of the Year Award:

- All projects certified by an official version of the LEED rating system and located in the USGBC NCR territory are eligible for nomination.
- Projects must have been awarded LEED Certification between June 15th, 2009 and June 18th, 2010.
- Projects will be judged on excellence in green building, design and construction, and overall community impact.

USGBC NCR Member Firm of the Year Award:

- USGBC Member Firms with offices in the USGBC NCR territory are eligible for nomination.
- Nominees will be judged on corporate leadership in energy and environmental stewardship through internal policies and initiatives.

USGBC NCR Member of the Year Award:

- All USGBC NCR Chapter members are eligible for nomination; you can nominate yourself.
- Nominees will be judged on their overall contribution and leadership in the green building community

APPLICATION REVIEW FEE

There is no application fee for USGBC NCR Member of the Year Award. Applications for USGBC NCR Project and Member Firm of the Year require an application review fee of the following:
USGBC National member firm - \$100.00
Non-member firm - \$150.00
